# INTERNATIONAL DIRECT INVESTMENT INFORMATION BULLETIN

#### 1) International Direct Investment Inflow<sup>1</sup>

#### Developments in Jnuary 2007

According to the balance of payment statistics of the Central Bank of Turkey, the net inflow has been \$ 6.106 million in January 2007 (Table-1).

The equity investment inflow, which represents the equity share transfers of international investors for their new or existing companies in Turkey, and for their participation into the existing domestic companies, has been \$ 5.870 million. \$ 5.651 million of this has been into financial intermediation sector (Table-2,3).

Equity investment inflow component of the international direct investment inflows reached up to \$5.870 million in the January 2007, representing a fifty-fold increase with respect to the same period in 2006, which was \$113 million (Table-6).

In the January 2007, majority of the total 216 companies with international capital is in the wholesale and retail trade sectors while real estate renting, other business activities and manufacturing sectors follow (Table-9). Textile goods production leads the manufacturing sector investments followed by machinery - equipment, chemicals and chemical products.

Of these total 216, 8 have capital values higher than \$500.000. Among these, 3 companies operate in manufacturing, 2 companies operate in wholesale and retail trade sectors and 2 companies operate in other community, social-personal service activities sector. Number of companies with international capital, capital value of which is greater than \$500.000, was 8 in the same period in 2006 (Table-9).

Currently, a total of 15.171 companies with international capital are operating in Turkey. Among these, 12.469 companies and branch offices with international capital have been established and 2.702 foreign capital participations to the existing companies incurred (Table-11).

Textile goods production leads the manufacturing sector investments followed by chemicals and food beverage products (Table-12).

When the distribution of the companies with international capital according to their country of origin is concerned, it is seen that 8.341 of the total 15.171 companies with foreign capital are of EU origin, in which Germany leads with 2.666 firms followed by United Kingdom (1.457 firms) and the Netherlands (1.199 firms) (Table-13).
