The equity investment inflow, which represents the equity share transfers of international investors for their new or existing companies in Turkey, and for their participation into the existing domestic companies, has been \$ 861 million. \$ 735 million of this has been into financial intermediation sector (Table-2).

In the January-September period in 2008, majority of the total 2.731 companies with international capital is in the wholesale and retail trade sectors while real estate renting and business activities and manufacturing sectors follow (Table-9). Chemicals-chemical products and machinery and equipment n.e.c lead the manufacturing sector investments followed by, food products and beverages sector.

Of these total 2.731, 269 have capital values higher than \$ 500.000. Among these, 52 companies operate in manufacturing, 45 companies operate in wholesale and retail trade sector and 30 companies operate in real estate, renting and business activities sectors (Table-9).

3) Investment Projects²

20 incentive certificates having a total investment value of \$ 397,4 million were issued by the Undersecretariat of Treasury in September 2008 for companies with international capital. Thus, In the first nine month of 2008, the number of certificated investment projects reached up to 170, while their capital value reached to \$ 5,1 billion (Table-17). 48,3 % of this capital will be covered by the international partners (Table-16).
