1) International Direct Investment Inflow¹

Developments in November 2011

The net international direct investment inflow has been \$ 510 million in November 2011 (Table-1).

The equity investment inflow, which represents the equity share transfers of international investors for their new or existing companies in Turkey, and for their participation into the existing domestic companies, has been \$ 323 million. \$ 78 million of this has been into electricity, gas and water supply sector and \$ 68 million of this has been into manufacturing sector (Table-2).

In the first eleven month of 2011, 2.879 companies and branch offices with international capital have been established and 471 international capital participations to the existing domestic companies incurred (Table-8).

In the January-November period in 2011, majority of the total 3.350 companies with international capital is in the wholesale and retail trade sectors while real estate renting and business activities sectors and manufacturing follow (Table-9). Chemicals-chemical products lead the manufacturing sector investments followed by food beverage products and machinery and equipment sectors.

Of these total 2.885, 282 have capital values higher than \$ 500000. Among these, 82 companies operate in wholesale and retail trade sector, 58 companies operate in manufacturing sector and 33 companies operate in transportation, storage and communication sector (Table-9).

Companies with international capital in Turkey

Currently, a total of 29.298 companies with international capital are operating in Turkey. Among these, 24.012 companies and branch offices with international capital have been established and 5.286 foreign capital participations to the existing companies incurred (Table-11).

As of the end of 2011, of the total of 29.298 companies with foreign capital which is operated in Turkey, 78% are limited companies, 19,8% are joint-stock companies and 2,2% are branch offices, commandite companies, collective companies, ordinary companies, business association and ordinary commandites.

Majority of the total 29.298 companies with international capital is in the wholesale and retail trade sectors while manufacturing, real estate renting and other business activities follow. Chemicals and chemical products leads the manufacturing sector investments followed by food beverage and tobacco products, textile products sectors (Table-12).

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When the distribution of the companies with international capital according to their country of origin is concerned, it is seen that 14.971 of the total 29.298 companies with foreign capital are of EU origin, in which Germany leads with 4.789 firms followed by United Kingdom (2.378 firms) and the Netherlands (2.001 firms) (Table-13).

When the investment location distribution of the 29.298 international capital companies are considered, it is seen that 16.274 of the total 29.298 are in Istanbul, which is followed by Antalya (3.494 firms), Ankara (1.903 firms) and Izmir (1.665 firms) (Table-14).

14 incentive certificates having a total investment value of \$ 334,9 million were issued by the Ministry of Economy in November 2011 for companies with international capital. Thus, in the first eleven month of 2011, the number of certificated investment projects reached up to 206, while their capital value reached to \$ 4,8 billion (Table-17). 45,6% of this capital will be covered by the international partners (Table-16).
