1) International Direct Investment Inflow¹

Developments in December 2014

The net international direct investment inflow has been \$ 1,244 million in December 2014 (Table-1).

In 2014, majority of the total 4,019 companies with international capital is in the wholesale and retail trade sectors while real estate renting and business activities and transport, storage and communications sectors follow (Table-9).

Of these total 4,019, 164 companies have capital values higher than \$ 500,000. Among these, 63 companies operate in wholesale and retail trade sector, 24 companies operate in manufacturing sector (Table-9).

Currently, a total of 41,528 companies with international capital are operating in Turkey. Among these, 35,231 companies and branch offices with international capital have been established and 6,297 foreign capital participations to the existing companies incurred (Table-11).

Chemicals and chemical products lead the manufacturing sector investments followed by food beverage products, textile goods production (Table-12).
