1) International Direct Investment Inflow¹

Developments in November 2015

The net international direct investment inflow (net incurrence of liabilities) has been \$ 682 million in November 2015 (Table-1).

The equity investment inflow, which represents the equity share transfers of international investors for their new or existing companies in Turkey, and for their participation into the existing domestic companies, has been \$ 312 million in November 2015.

In the January-November period in 2015, majority of the total 4,632 companies with international capital is operating in the wholesale and retail trade sectors while real estate, renting and business activities and transport, storage and communications and construction sectors follow (Table-9).

Of these total 4,632, 147 companies have capital values higher than \$ 500,000. Among these, 59 companies operate in wholesale and retail trade sector, 20 companies operate in real estate, renting and business activities sector (Table-9).

Currently, a total of 46,720 companies with international capital are operating in Turkey. Among these, 40,254 companies and branch offices with international capital have been established and 6,466 foreign capital participations to the existing companies incurred (Table-11).

When the distribution of the companies with international capital according to their country of origin is concerned, it is seen that 20,523 of the total 46,720 companies with foreign capital are of EU origin, in which Germany leads with 6,445 firms followed by United Kingdom (2,900 firms) and the Netherlands (2,570 firms) (Table-13).

3) Investment Projects²

22 incentive certificates having a total investment value of \$ 161.5 million were issued by the Ministry of Economy in November 2015 for companies with international capital. Thus, in January-November period of 2015, the number of certificated investment projects reached up to 207, while their investment value has reached to \$ 13,180.5 million (Table-16).
