In the January-April period in 2016, majority of the total 1,974 companies with international capital is in the wholesale and retail trade sectors while real estate, renting and business activities and transport, storage and communications sectors follow (Table-9).

Of these total 1,974, 58 companies have capital values higher than \$ 500,000. Among these, 22 companies operate in wholesale and retail trade sector, 8 companies operate in transport, storage and communications sector (Table-9).

Currently, a total of 49,551 companies with international capital are operating in Turkey. Among these, 43,027 companies and branch offices with international capital have been established and 6,524 foreign capital participations to the existing companies incurred (Table-11).

3) Investment Projects²

23 incentive certificates having a total investment value of \$ 130.1 million were issued by the Ministry of Economy in April 2016 for companies with international capital. Thus, in January – April period of 2016, the number of certificated investment projects reached up to 68, while their investment value reached to \$ 558.8 million (Table-16).
