#### 1) International Direct Investment Inflow<sup>1</sup>

#### Developments in June 2016

The net international direct investment inflow has been \$ 597 million in June 2016 (Table-1).

The equity investment inflow, which represents the equity share transfers of international investors for their new or existing companies in Turkey, and for their participation into the existing domestic companies, has been \$ 272 million in June 2016.

In the January-June period in 2016, majority of the total 3,032 companies with international capital is in the wholesale and retail trade sectors while real estate, renting and business activities and transportation, storage and communications sectors follow (Table-9).

Of these total 3,032, 95 companies have capital values higher than \$ 500,000. Among these, 36 companies operate in wholesale and retail trade sector, 11 companies operate in real estate, renting and business activities sector (Table-9).

#### Companies with international capital in Turkey

Currently, a total of 50,643 companies with international capital are operating in Turkey. Among these, 44,065 companies and branch offices with international capital have been established and 6,578 foreign capital participations to the existing companies incurred (Table-11).

Majority of the total 50,643 companies with international capital is in the wholesale and retail trade sectors while real estate renting and other business activities and manufacturing follow. Chemicals and chemical products lead the manufacturing sector investments followed by textile goods and food beverage products (Table-12).

When the distribution of the companies with international capital according to their country of origin is concerned, it is seen that 21,224 of the total 50,643 companies with foreign capital are of EU origin, in which Germany leads with 6,711 firms followed by United Kingdom (2,964 firms) and the Netherlands (2,659 firms) (Table-13).

#### 3) Investment Projects<sup>2</sup>

27 incentive certificates having a total investment value of \$ 540 million were issued by the Ministry of Economy in June 2016 for companies with international capital. Thus, in January – June period of 2016, the number of certificated investment projects reached up to 108, while their investment value reached to \$ 2,334.1 million (Table-16).
