

## List C of ANNEX II Referred to in Article 4 of the Agreement

Duty rates will be reduced as follows:

- a) on 1 January 2010, the import duty will be reduced to 85 % of the basic duty;
- b) on 1 January 2011, the import duty will be reduced to 70 % of basic duty;
- c) on 1 January 2012, the import duty will be reduced to 55 % of basic duty;
- d) on 1 January 2013, the import duty will be reduced to 40 % of basic duty;
- e) on 1 January 2014, the import duty will be reduced to 20 % of basic duty;
- f) on 1 January 2015, the remaining import duties will be abolished.
