Turkey, Singapore Aim For \$2B Trade Volume By 2018



Turkey-Singapore Business Forum was organized on August 21, 2017 Turkish Prime Minister Binali Yıldırım, Turkish Minister of Economy Nihat Zeybekci and Singaporean Minister of Trade and Industry S. Iswaran as well as approximately 200 Turkish and Singaporean business people have participated to the Business Forum. In his speech, Turkish Minister of Economy Nihat Zeybekci reminded that the Free Trade Agreement concluded on November 2015 between Singapore

and Turkey is the most comprehensive agreement ever signed in Turkish history and the most inclusionary agreement in terms of sectors. Minister Zeybekci, stating that they aim to reach to a trade volume worth of 2 billion USD between Turkey and Singapore as of the end of 2018, further said that this Agreement would provide leverage especially with respect to making joint business in third countries. Minister Zeybekci, stating, "2018 would be a brand-new year of inception for Turkey and Singapore", invited Singaporean business representatives to effectively benefit and practice upon the investment and incentive thrust initiated by Turkey. 

Turkish Contractors Rank Second In The Top 250 International Contractors List

Turkey ranked in second place after China for the number of contracting companies building the largest volume of projects across the world outside their home countries, according to the latest list of the world's "top 250 contractors" by the magazine Engineering News Record (ENR). The number of Turkish companies on the list reached 46, while China topped the list with 65 companies and the U.S. ranked third with 43 companies.

According to data from Turkish Contractors Association, Turkish contracting companies successfully compete on 5 continents and in 115 countries offering affordable services of high quality. They are open to enhancing international partnerships not only in the field of contracting, but also in construction industry investments, ranging from the production of building materials to infrastructure, housing, industrial plants and tourism projects in the African, Eurasian and Middle Eastern countries. Turkish contractors continue to increase their competitiveness with extensive know-how and experience gained in all kinds of challenging projects and in all forms of business environments. Sectoral Reports: Dried Fruits



Dried fruits are one of Turkey's major agricultural sectors and Turkey is the one of leading countries in the world with respect to the production and export of dried fruits. Turkish dried fruits production and exports are considerably high and dominate world markets. Among the dried fruits produced in Turkey, raisins (sultanas), dried apricots and dried figs have the lion's share. Because of their major importance for agricultural exports, they are regarded as traditional Turkish agricultural export items. Turkey also produces and exports other kinds of dried fruits such as prunes, currants, dried apples, dried pears, dried mulberries, dried peaches etc. In terms of quantity nearly 25% of world dried fruit exports come from Turkey. Turkey exports dried fruits to the five continents of the world and to 133 countries. Nearly 65% of the exports are directed to European Union Countries. 45% of exports

were directed to 4 countries, namely UK, Germany, France and the USA in 2016. Apart from the EU countries; the USA, Australia, Canada and Brazil are the other important destinations for Turkish dried fruits. For the full report, please visit the Ministry of Economy website.
