Export Figures Broke All Time Record in Monthly Basis in October



dollars and apparels with 1,6 billion dollars.

In October, exports increased by 13.1 percent compared to the same month of the previous year and rose 15.7 billion dollars. Thus, Turkey broke the highest monthly export record in its history.

In October, automotive was the leading sector with 2.9 billion dollars. The sector's exports increased by 11,1 percent compared to the same month of the previous year. Automotive was followed by chemicals with 1,6 billion

Turkey's exports to 159 countries and regions increased in October. Germany is in the first place with 1,5 billion dollars. Germany was followed by UK with 1,1 billion dollars, Italia with 879 million dollars and Iraq with 853 million dollars.

According to the provisional data, produced with the cooperation of the Turkish Statistical Institute and the Ministry of Trade, In January - September 2018 period, exports were 123 billion 43 million dollars with a 7% increase and imports were 174 billion 155 million dollars with a 3.1% increase compared to January – September 2017 period.

Turkish Steel Sector is Unbreakable

Turkey is the world's eighth-largest steel exporter and Turkey's exports represented about 4 percent of all steel exported globally in 2017. In value terms, steel represented 5.8 percent of the total amount of goods Turkey exported in 2017.


Turkey's steel exports recently peaked in 2012, reaching a high of 18.4 million metric tons. By 2017, steel exports had recovered from the lows of 14.8 and 15 million metric tons in 2015 and 2016. Turkey's steel exports rose 12.5 percent in the first



nine months of the year when compared to the same period last year, reaching 14.7 million tons. The Turkish Steel Exporters' Association (ÇİB) revealed that the country earned \$11 billion between January and September up 34 percent compared to the same period last year.

Sectoral Reports: Pharmaceutical Industry



The production and marketing of all pharmaceuticals in Turkey are authorized by the Turkish Ministry of Health and pharmaceutical products and firms must be registered in the Ministry.

Since 1995, pharmaceutical manufacturers have to abide by regulations specifying Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP), Good Laboratory Practices (GLP) and Good Clinical Practices (GCP) requiring significant investment by local industry companies. The necessary investments for the development of technology in the industry have been accelerated and today the production technology of the Turkish pharmaceutical industry has reached world standards.

The production of raw materials in Turkey concentrates on the active ingredients of antibiotics and analgesics, by using the methods of



fermentation, extraction and synthesis. Within the Turkish pharmaceutical raw materials sector, 11 plants are owned by the private sector.

Turkey is now exporting various pharmaceutical products to 153 countries including developed countries like South Korea, Switzerland, Poland, Slovenia, Germany, the UK, the USA and Georgia. In 2017 the total value of pharmaceuticals export increased to US \$ 909,8 million.
