## **Turkey's Foreign Trade Deficit Shrank**



Turkey's foreign trade gap in 2018 narrowed by 28.4 percent year-onyear, the Turkish Statistical Institute (Turkstat) announced.

The figure reached \$55 billion last year, down from a \$76.8 billion deficit in 2017, according to TÜİK. Turkish exports rose 7 percent on a yearly basis to hit \$168 billion, as imports dropped to \$223 billion, indicating a decrease of 4.6 percent.

In the New Economic Program, the

government had forecast a foreign trade deficit of \$66 billion for 2018. It had forecast exports and imports at \$170 billion and \$236 billion, respectively.

The government expects the country's foreign trade shortfall to shrink to \$62 billion this year. Its export and import forecasts are \$182 billion and \$244 billion, respectively.



#### Sectoral Reports: Technical Textiles and Nonwovens Industry



Technical textiles and nonwovens is the most developing and promising sector in the global textile industry. The production and consumption of technical textiles and nonwovens has gained great economic value in the last decade.

The demand for technical textiles and nonwovens is directly related to overall economic developments and textile technology. The increase in GDP per capita in Turkey in recent years has fueled demand for technical textile and nonwoven products such as feminine hygiene products, diapers, medical textiles and disposable products. In addition, rapid growth and the requirements in the automotive, construction, filtration, agriculture and chemical industries have stimulated demand for technical textiles and nonwovens.

The major end-user sectors for technical textiles and nonwovens

in Turkey are automotive, packaging, hygiene, medical supplies, construction, clothing, military, agriculture and filtration.

## Turkish Jewelry Aims To Set New Export Record in 2019

Turkish Jewelry, with its 7000-year-long heritage, continues to increase export volumes with more than 35.000 retail brands, 6.000 producers and 1.000 service firms. Turkey is one of the leading jewelry markets in the world together with the United Kingdom, the USA, China, the UAE, and India.

Turkey has the 11th largest stock of gold in the world. In 2017, it was the 10th highest global exporter of jewelry, reaching a value of \$4.1 billion and constituting 4.5% of the world jewelry exports.

A new record was set in 2018, with total exports amounting to \$4.54 billion, a 35% increase compared to the previous year.




Boosted by this continuous increase, Turkey's Jewelry sector has set its target for 2023 to \$12 billion in exports.

## Trade in Electronic Components Drives Growth in Technology Goods



Demand for electronic components used in Internet-of-Things (IoT) devices drove the value of trade in international imports of information and communications technology (ICT) goods in 2017 to reach \$2.1 trillion, according to new figures released by UNCTAD.

Trade in ICT goods grew slightly faster than merchandise trade and represented 13.4% of the total in 2017, down from the 16.1% high during the dot-com boom in 2000 but the highest in two years. By

comparison, in 2017 machinery and transport equipment accounted for 37% and food for 8% of merchandise imports.
